Keifukuji Mountain

e legendary "Funakoka" of Harima Fudoki shozan Keifukuji Temple of the Soto sect was nded in 1369 in Settsu Province by Monk sugen Jakurei, the sixth generation from Monk gen, founder of Daihonzan Eiheiji Temple It moved to Harima to avoid military fire during e Tensho Period and was later built in Sakatanachi under the devotion of Terumasa Ikeda, lord f Himeji. In 1862 (Meiji 11), the Rikugun Hime unior High School, the predecessor of the old limeii Junior High School, was opened he Keifukuii Nurserv School and Zuisho Gakue still stand today. There is a graveyard for the wi e of the Sakai family, lords of the Himeji domain the precincts of the temple.
