



#### ④Himeji Shrine

The deity worshipped is Masachika Sakai, the last lord of Himeji Castle and the founder of the Sakai clan. Within the grounds stands Suno Shrine and bust of Kawai Suno, who served the Sakai family for 50 years over four generations and contributed to the financial reconstruction of the Himeji domain.



## 6 Shirakawa Shrine

Located in a residential area between the Sembra River and middle mort of Himeji Castle, you can enjoy a row of cherry blossom trees opposite the torii gate facing east. The local residents have deep faith in the shrine, and you always see people visiting. It is said to bring good luck to your eyes.



### ⑧Otokoyama Water Reservoir Park

Once you reach the top of the 197 steps, you'll be rewarded with a panoramic view of Himeji Castle and the city. There are also Mizuo Shrine, Otokoyama Hachimangu Shrine, Senhime Tenmangu Shrine. It has also selected as one of the Top Ten Views of Himeji and the Top Eight View of Sanjo Area.



**10 Senhime's path**  
The promenade along the middle moat of Himeji Castle. The Samba River and the Ono River join at Shimizumori Gate, and a promenade continues to National Route 2. Near by are Kiyomizu Jizo Statue, Shirakawa Shrine, the Shingon sect's Fudojin Temple. Which is the family temple of Ikeda Terumasa, and the Himeji City Museum of Literature.



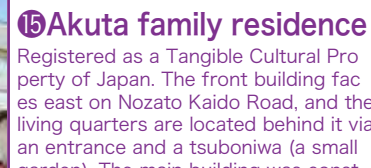
## ☪ bread and espresso with Himeji Castle

Every 3rd Sat. of the month.

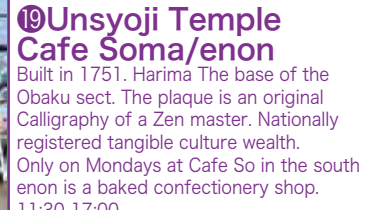


**16 Former Katsuhara Pharmacy**

There is a tomb of married couple for Onatsu Seijuro.



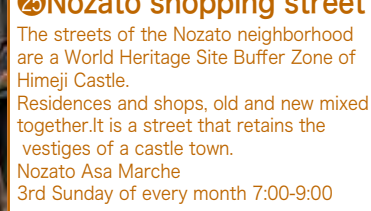
**20 Kokuraya**
